COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAM
General Information

The Office of the State's Attorney's has implemented a voluntary community service program for adults.

Acceptance into the program will be decided by the prosecutor on your trial date.

In court, you will receive an application, verification sheet and a set of guidelines.

Detach the application and mail with a one-time application fee of \$100.00 to enroll into the program. The application fee must be in the form of a money order or cashier's check, made payable to **Worcester County**. Please include your name, address and case number on the money order.

The guidelines and verification sheet are provided for you to successfully complete the program. Do not lose this paperwork.

Once you have been offered community service, your case will be placed on the STET docket and you will have 90 days to complete the community service and submit verification letter to this office via email for approval.

Failure to register for this program, handing in paperwork incorrectly, late, or not at all will void the offer and result in your case being set for trial.

Failure to appear on your trial date will result in a bench warrant being issued for your arrest.

This office **does not** send confirmation of completed community service paperwork. Make copies of everything you send to this office. It is your responsibility to make sure that the paperwork arrives on time.

Once the Office of the State's Attorney has reviewed your completed community service and accepted it, the case will be removed from the STET docket and set in for a Nolle Prosequi (dismissal).

The District Court of Maryland will then set case on the docket to be dismissed and you do not need to attend.

After dismissal, any questions should be directed towards either the Snow Hill or Ocean City District Court.
